“Vessel” Definition

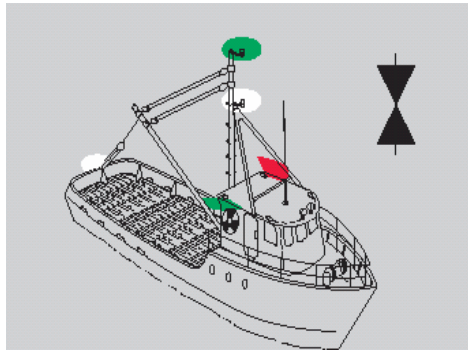
The word "vessel" includes every description of watercraft, including non-displacement craft, and seaplanes, used or capable of being used as a means of transportation on water.

Rule 3 (d)

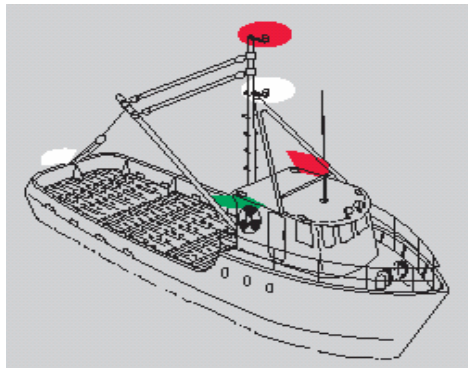
“Vessel Engaged in Fishing” Definition

The term "vessel engaged in fishing" means any vessel fishing with nets, lines, trawls, or other fishing apparatus which restrict maneuverability, but does not include a vessel fishing with trolling lines or other fishing apparatus which do not restrict maneuverability.

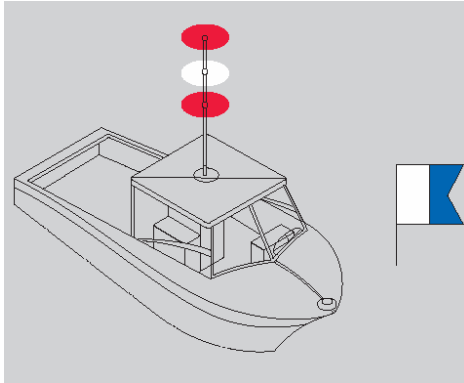
Fishing Nav Lights Trawling

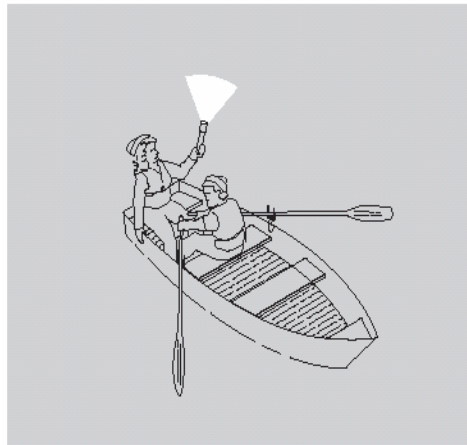


Nav Lights

Under oars

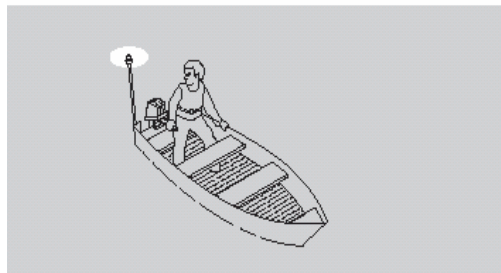
*Electric Torch or

All around white light

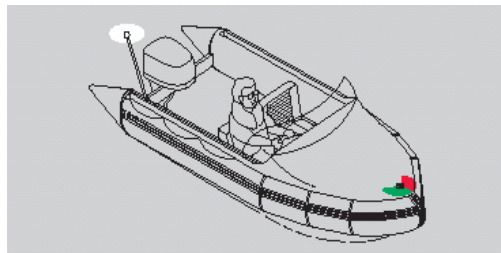


Nav Lights

light*



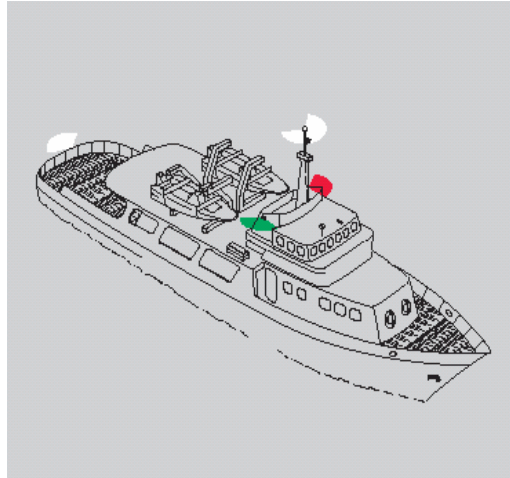
